

Imagine a journey where every pedal stroke connects you with the earth, the aroma of freshly roasted coffee, the endless mountains of the Coffee Region, and the flavors of a vibrant culture.

The Bonobo Coffee Tour is much more than cycling: it's a deep immersion in the essence of Colombia, where the landscapes take your breath away and local stories steal your heart.

This 6-day tour was designed for passionate cyclists looking to challenge themselves, reconnect, and experience something authentic. We'll climb the legendary Alto de Letras, cross ancient coffee plantations, and rest on farms with soul, savoring every stretch with the dedication and passion that characterizes Bonobo.

Our Itinerary

Day 1: Welcome to Colombia

We welcome you with open arms at the Pereira or Armenia airports. We recommend arriving in the morning, as we'll begin our journey by car to the municipality of El Líbano, a coffee-growing town nestled in the mountains of Tolima, famous for its rural culture, agricultural history, and for being the gateway to Alto de Letras.

Upon arrival, settle in, rest, and prepare for the great adventure. In the evening, we'll welcome you with a welcome dinner, where we'll give you your Bonobo kit and share all the details of what's to come. This is where your story in the heart of coffee begins!

Day 2: Murillo > Alto del Sifón > Alto de Letras

ST 1: 59 km - 1.887 mtr+

Get ready to face one of the most epic stages in world cycling: the climb to Alto de Letras and Alto de Letras. We start from Murillo. During the journey, we'll cross three thermal zones, moving from a temperate climate to areas of páramo and mist, where oxygen is scarce but excitement overflows. We'll cross the Nevados National Park, home to frailejones, pristine waters, and unparalleled biodiversity. Reaching Letras is a feat, but more than a medal, it's a moment of introspection and power. This is the ultimate stage. At the end, we'll take you to a luxury accommodation where you'll rest like a champion deserves.

Day 3: Rest Day in the Hotel Condor's Nest

After the titanic effort of the previous day, today we'll take it easy. We'll wake up at the Nido del Condor Hotel, one of the most incredible and little-known spots in all of Colombia. The plan for the day is to enjoy a relaxing day. You can take a morning horseback ride around the hotel or go on a birdwatching tour. In the afternoon, you can relax, enjoy the mountains, and read a good book! Tomorrow we'll get back on the bike!





Day 4: Coffee Ride

ST 2: 72 km - 1.792mtr+

We return to the ring with a stage that embodies everything we love at Bonobo: quiet roads, endless views, and a deep connection with the environment. The route winds through coffee farms and rural villages, where the greenery seems to come in a thousand shades. This section is one of our hidden treasures, little known even by many locals, but strikingly beautiful. We finish in Marsella, where we have lunch, and then drive to Filandia, one of the most beautiful towns in Quindío, where we will spend the night.

Day 5: Filandia > Valle del Cocorá > Salento

ST 3: 45 km / 1.435 mtr+

The final stage is a tribute to the natural beauty of Quindío. We depart from Filandia on a shorter but unforgettable journey, crossing the colorful town of Salento and gently ascending to the iconic Cocora Valley, home to the towering wax palms, Colombia's national tree and a species endemic to the region.


Riding through these lands means ending the tour on a high note: amidst mist, mountains, and pristine nature. Upon reaching the valley, we'll have time for photos, hikes, and a good cup of coffee. At night, in Salento, we'll share a farewell dinner, celebrating the adventure together.

Day 6: Farewell Day

After breakfast, our team will return you to the Pereira or Armenia airport, your choice. The journey takes between 1 and 1.5 hours, so we recommend an afternoon flight. Beyond the physical challenge, the Bonobo Coffee Tour is an experience for the senses and the soul. We hope you leave with a smile on your face, a vibrant body, and a heart in love with this coffee-producing corner of Colombia.



CO2 footprint

Although cycling is more sustainable than driving, we still leave a CO2 footprint. At Bonobo, we offset this footprint by covering the emissions generated by your flights, transportation, accommodations, and other services. For each participant, we plant three trees through the ReverdC reforestation program, a Colombian company. You'll also receive an offset certificate in your name.

Social & Community
