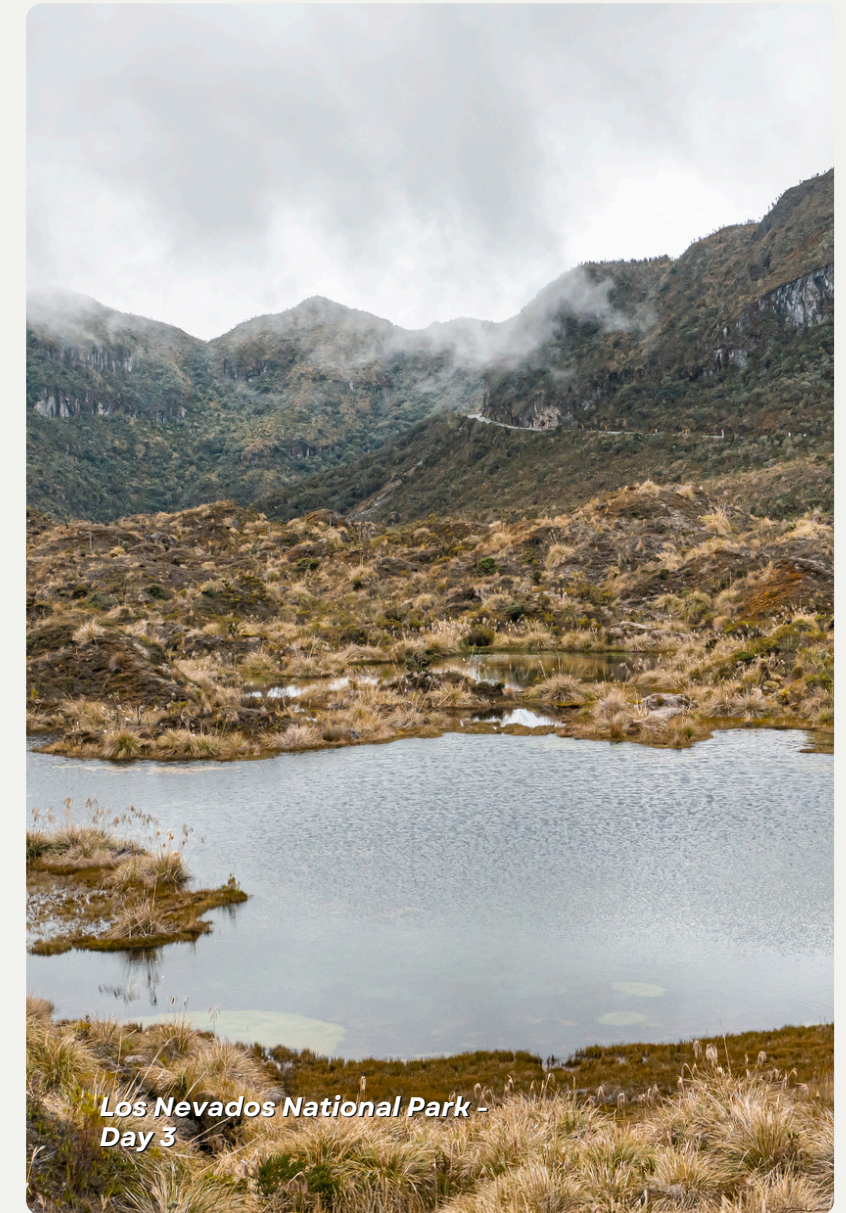

Our Itinerary

Day 1: Welcome to Colombia

Your journey can begin from three different cities: Bogotá, Medellín, or Ibagué... however, each city involves different travel times to Honda.. Our destination: Honda, a colonial town nestled on the banks of the Magdalena River, Colombia's most important waterway. Tonight, we rest in the tropics, where history, heat, and adventure set the tone for what's to come.

Day 2: Short ride in Honda & Transfer to Libano

ST 1: 44 km / 438 mtr+

After a long travel day, we'll ease into the adventure with a short recovery ride through the colonial charm of Honda, nestled along the banks of the Magdalena River. It's the perfect warm-up. In the afternoon, we head up into the mountains toward Líbano, a town surrounded by coffee plantations and Andean forests — a sign that the real climbs are just beginning.

Day 3: Queen Stage - Conquering the Central Andes

ST 2: 82 km / 3.284 mtr+

Today is nothing short of legendary. We'll ride through Colombia's most iconic high-mountain roads, conquering Alto del Sifón and the mighty Alto de Letras. We'll traverse páramo landscapes, surrounded by frailejones, deep canyons, and endless silence. The ride ends at Termales del Ruiz — a mountaintop hotel with natural hot springs. After an epic day, you've earned every second of rest.

Day 4: Coffee Ride

ST 3: 70 km / 1.793 mtr+

After yesterday's grandeur, we slow down to soak it all in. Our ride begins in Manizales and takes us deep into the coffee lands. Expect winding roads, vibrant green hills, and timeless rural life. We'll arrive in Marsella, a picturesque coffee town filled with tradition and soul. This stage is all about connection — with the land, the people, and the rhythm of the region.



Our Itinerary

Day 5: Rest Day & Transfer to Cauca Viejo

Time to pause. We'll wake up in a traditional coffee hacienda where nature and culture blend perfectly. The morning is yours: rest, breathe, reflect. After lunch, we travel toward the magical Suroeste Antioqueño. A place of colorful villages, powerful rivers, and mountain dreams. The roads rest today... the anticipation builds for what's to come.

Day 6: Conquering the Western Andes (Jericó Climb)

ST 4: 72 km / 2.186 mtr+

Today we take on the mighty Western Andes. The 21 km climb to Jericó is both demanding and breathtaking —steep gradients, lush biodiversity, and ever-changing views of the Cauca River Valley. Once in Jericó, we'll enjoy coffee and a short town visit before continuing to Tarso for lunch. In the afternoon we will have the transfer to Medellín to spend the last night

Day 7: Conquering Alto de Palmas + Departure Day

ST 5: 73 km / 1.798 mtr+

Alto de Palmas is an iconic climb in Colombian cycling, which is why we chose it as the first climb of our tour. We'll depart from the hotel, and the ascent begins just 3 kilometers away. Once at the summit, we'll continue towards El Retiro, a traditional coffee-growing town, and from there we'll embark on a loop through the eastern forests. In the afternoon we venture out to explore Medellín, where we'll finish with a nice farewell dinner for the whole group!

Day 8: Farewell

All good things come to an end, but Colombia will stay with you. After breakfast, we'll transfer back to Medellín. Whether you're heading home or continuing your travels, we'll make sure you leave full of stories, memories... and maybe already dreaming of coming back. Airport or hotel drop-off, depending on your plans.

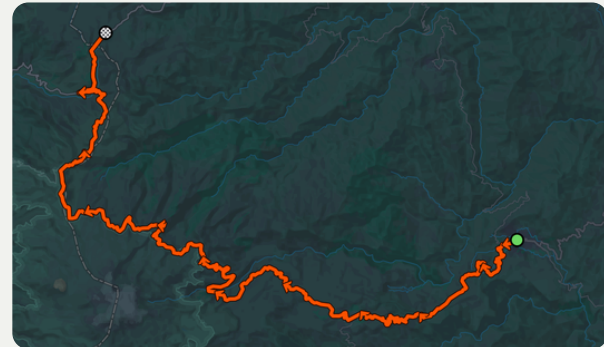

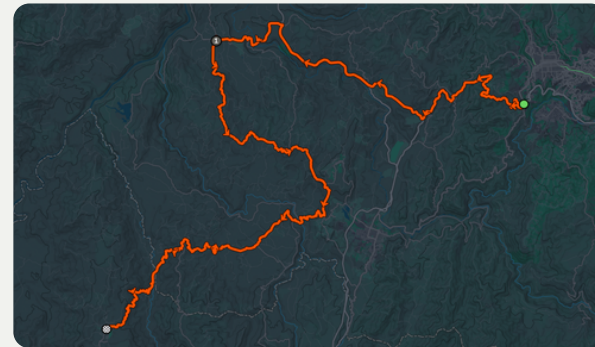

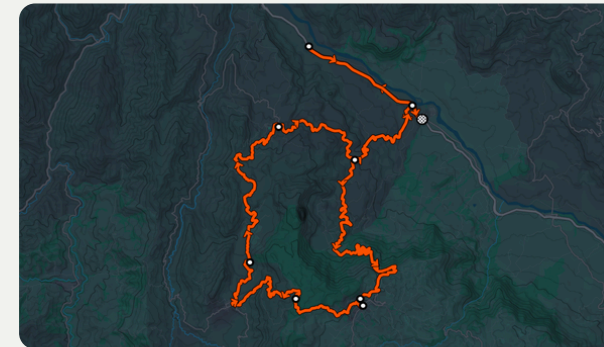

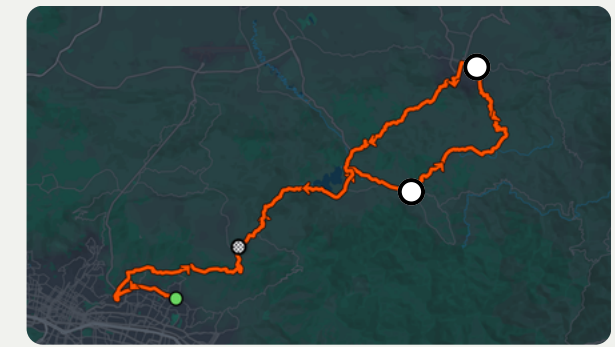

CO2 footprint

Although cycling is more sustainable than driving, we still leave a CO2 footprint. At Bonobo, we offset this footprint by covering the emissions generated by your flights, transportation, accommodations, and other services. For each participant, we plant three trees through the ReverdC reforestation program, a Colombian company. You'll also receive an offset certificate in your name.

Social & Community

At Bonobo, we know that tourism is key to economic and social development. That's why, beyond offering you unique cycling experiences in Colombia, we ensure we leave a positive mark on the communities we visit, generating a direct economic impact through both our operations and our customers' spending. In this way, we support the growth and strengthening of these regions.

At Bonobo, we are committed to responsible consumption. Since 2022, we have reduced the use of single-use plastics by 80%. Furthermore, our purchasing policy requires that the products we purchase be recyclable, manufactured using sustainable practices, and have an environmentally responsible production process.
