Over 8 unforgettable days, you'll ride through some of the most iconic destinations in Antioquia – from vibrant Medellín to the charming towns of Santa Fe de Antioquia, Cauca Viejo, and Jardín. Expect breathtaking mountains, rich traditions, and the kind of landscapes you can't put into words. The Cauca River will guide us, winding between the Central and Western Andes. Along the way, you'll discover places like El Retiro, La Ceja, Jericó, and Tarso – each one adding a unique chapter to this emotional, scenic journey.

Beyond the bike, you'll enjoy a city tour through Medellín, including the famous Comuna 13, an exclusive coffee experience, and a surprise activity designed to make this trip even more unforgettable. Our dedicated team will be with you every step of the way, taking care of your bike, keeping you fueled, and making sure all you have to do is ride, smile, and take it all in.

We promise: this will be an experience you'll never forget.

Our Itinerary

Day 1: Welcome to Colombia

We'll meet you at the José María Córdova International Airport and take you straight to our hotel in Medellín, where we'll be staying for the next three nights. In the evening, we'll gather for a welcome dinner – a chance to meet the team, receive your rider kit, and hear all about the unforgettable days that lie ahead.

Day 2: Medellín > Alto del Palmas > Vuelta a Oriente

ST 1: 59 km - 1.701 mtr+

Alto de Palmas is a cycling icon in Colombia, which is why we've chosen it as the opening climb of our tour. We'll start riding right from the hotel, and just 3 kilometers in, the ascent begins. Once we reach the summit, we'll continue along the "Vuelta a Oriente" – a route loved by local cyclists for its beauty and challenge. In the afternoon, you'll have free time to explore Medellín at your own pace. Our support vehicle will be at your disposal to help you make the most of the city.

Day 3: Medellín > Alto de la Unión > Alto de Carrizales.

ST 2: 82 km - 1.643 mtr+

For our second stage, we'll leave the hotel by vehicle to reach the starting point of today's ride. We begin in Llanogrande and head toward our main challenge of the day: Alto La Unión, the toughest climb of the stage. At the top, we'll pause in the charming town of La Unión to enjoy a well-deserved cup of coffee. From there, we ride back along a scenic route that includes two more climbs: Alto del Nano and Alto de Carrizales. In the afternoon, you'll have time to relax and enjoy the hotel's amenities before we gather again for dinner.

Day 4: Alto de Palmas > Parque Arví

ST 3: 45 km - 922 mtr+

We always say the fourth day marks the true beginning of the adventure. Today's ride is short but deeply rewarding, as we head toward Parque Arví – a peaceful natural reserve and one of Medellín's most iconic green spaces. After our visit, we'll return to the hotel for a refreshing shower and check-out. Then, we set off toward Santa Fe de Antioquia, a charming colonial town known for its well-preserved architecture and the iconic Puente de Occidente – a 19th-century engineering marvel. We'll spend the night here, right before diving into the legendary Southwest of Antioquia.





Day 5: Santa Fe de Antioquia > Cauca Viejo

ST 4: 96 km - 827mtr+

As we told you, the most exciting part of the tour begins! Sunrise and the start of the stage from Santa Fe de Antioquia are an unforgettable experience in themselves. Today we will travel 91 km along the majestic Cauca River, which will be the center of our adventure for the next few days. This river, one of the most important in Colombia, is not only vital to the region's biodiversity but also plays an essential role in the country's ecological balance and economic development. Along the way, you will marvel at the magnitude of this river, its impressive biodiversity, and its influence on the surrounding communities. We will end the stage at one of the area's most popular restaurants, and then take a 10-minute transfer to our magical destination: Cauca Viejo.

Day 6: Cauca Viejo > Jericó

ST 5: 72 km / 2.186 mtr+

We've explored countless routes across Colombia – and this one is truly among our favorites. The climb to Jericó is nothing short of spectacular. As you ride, the landscape transforms dramatically, with sweeping views over the Cauca River valley and a climb that tests your legs and rewards your soul. Once in Jericó, you'll be captivated by its charm – a town rich in history, culture, and color. We'll enjoy lunch in the plaza, take a stroll through its streets, and then head back to Cauca Viejo... where a special surprise awaits.

Day 7: Cauca Viejo > Fredonia

ST 6: 46 km - 1.570 mtr+

For our second stage, we'll leave the hotel by vehicle to reach the starting point of today's ride. We begin in Llanogrande and head toward our main challenge of the day: Alto La Unión, the toughest climb of the stage. At the top, we'll pause in the charming town of La Unión to enjoy a well-deserved cup of coffee. From there, we ride back along a scenic route that includes two more climbs: Alto del Nano and Alto de Carrizales. Day 8: Farewell Day



Our greatest wish is for every guest to leave happy – and in love with Colombia.

At Bonobo, we offset this footprint by covering the emissions generated by your flights, transportation, accommodations, and other services. For each participant, we plant three trees through the ReverdC reforestation program, a Colombian company. You'll also receive an offset certificate in your name.
